Prices for the Right of Entombment

The Right to Place a Casket in a Mausoleum Crypt

Prices include bronze crypt plate for memorialization with names and dates.

Right of Entombment in Garden of Ascension Mausoleum

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| • Rows A (lowest level) and D, crypt for two side-by-side | \$15,500.00 |
| • Rows A (lowest level) and D, crypt for one | \$7,750.00 |
| • Rows B and C, crypt for two side-by-side | \$16,500.00 |
| • Rows B and C, crypt for one | \$8,250.00 |
| • Row E (highest level), crypt for two side-by-side | \$14,500.00 |
| • Row E (highest level), crypt for one side | \$7,250.00 |

Guidelines for Casket Construction and Crypt Capacity

Caskets for entombment must be constructed of metal. Metal caskets for entombment must be sealed by a protective gasket mechanism around the entire perimeter of the closure. Whether for single casket or double casket crypts, each casket must not exceed the following height, width, and length dimensions:

- ❖ **Height** – top to bottom of a casket in the crypt – **Not to Exceed 24 Inches**
- ❖ **Width** – left to right of a casket in the crypt including side handles – **Not to Exceed 29 Inches**
- ❖ **Length** – end to end in the crypt including end handles – **Not to Exceed 84 Inches**
